Grace Members and Friends,

We will hold our first in-person worship service in the Sanctuary this Sunday, October 18, at 11am. Gathering together will include some modifications to our pre-pandemic practices:

- Congregation members must self-screen. If you are ill, coughing, sneezing, running a fever, feeling lousy or have been exposed to someone with Covid-19, you must stay home.
- Congregation members and visitors must RSVP. To do so, simply call the church office or click the Eventbrite link in this email to reserve your spot for Sunday or future dates.
- Enter only through the east or west narthex doors.
- Watch for signs as you enter to direct you to check-in.
- Masks must be worn by everyone.
- Those not in the same family will need to be at least six feet apart
- Any fellowship must take place outside and not in the Narthex.

For those not yet comfortable gathering, online worship and mailed worship resources will continue. Remember, we are one in the Spirit, no matter where we are worshiping.

We have two other gathering opportunities in the near future:

On Saturday, October 31, at 10am in the circle driveway, we will have a **Blessing of the Animals** service. Normally celebrated on the Feast of St. Frances (October 4), this short liturgy and prayer time recognizes that our animals are gifts from God to comfort us, protect us, and bring us joy. They have been especially present to us during the pandemic. The service will include a blessing for each animal who attends with their person/people. Please bring a lawn chair and mask for each human and a leash/carrier for each pet. On Monday, November 2, at 7pm, we will hold a non-partisan prayer service for our nation and election. This service will be in the Sanctuary. Please RSVP through the Eventbrite link or by calling the church office.
