

- Day School had a deficit of (\$1,417) for October. YTD loss of \$192,914 was funded by PPP.
- General offering is up 10% from last month, down about 8% from last October.
- Overall deficit of (\$25,171) for October due mostly to additional property expenses.
- Overall surplus of \$57,631 YTD October thanks to PPP loan proceeds.
- Without PPP loan and excluding day school, church has YTD deficit of (\$20,322).
- Major capital repairs fund balance is \$81,152.
- Capital campaign fund balance is \$35,203.
- Cash reserve balance is \$168,451.
- In August, we borrowed \$100,000 from a maximum loan of \$500,000 from PCUSA to fund a portion of the HVAC replacements.
- A forgivable PPP Loan in the amount of \$270,042.50 was received in April.
