Mission Updates ESL/ Citizenship Classes

This fall, we had about 50 students register for ESL and citizenship classes. We average about 20 students in attendance every week. Nationalities from 15 countries are represented, including Ukraine, India, Peru, Venezuela, Vietnam etc. We are also serving members of our Afghan guests residing at Grace Place.

Refugee Update

We are again blessed to extend Christian hospitality to sojourners by providing shelter in Grace Place for a family from Afghanistan. Working with Refugee Services of Texas we are helping a family with five children, ranging in age from 2 to 12, to get settled in the area. Volunteers are providing English training, Sunday dinners and rides for outings, shopping and to medical and other appointments. Members of the Quilting Ministry provided a sewing machine and supplies and within a day each of the three daughters had a new dress and pair of pants made by their mother. The family is very appreciative of your support and looking forward to a new life in the US.
