This Sunday is Christ the King Sunday. It is celebrated on the last Sunday of the liturgical year. It celebrates Christ's messianic kingship and sovereign rule over all creation. The Apostle Paul reminds us that one day, "at the name of Jesus every knee will bow in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord" (Philippians 2:10-11).

And yet, in our gospel reading for this Sunday, we find Jesus not on a throne, but on a cross. Not ruling and reigning but suffering and dying. Not judging and condemning but loving and accepting. Not imposing his will on his people but allowing them to kill him. Why in the world would this awful passage in the middle of Jesus' humiliation, suffering and death (Luke 23:33-43) be the lectionary passage for this special day we celebrate his kingship? What does this teach us about Jesus, "The King of the Jews"?

Testimony HQ

We have good news! Our church is one of eight within a 350-mile radius of Dallas to be selected for Testimony HQ, a Lilly Endowment-funded initiative at SMU Perkins School of Theology. The purpose of this initiative is to help congregations thrive through the practice of testimony as community engagement. Our congregation will commit 2023 to learning effective ways to give our testimony and thus engage with our community. We will receive up to \$5000 in grant funding to support our efforts, and we will be visited early in 2023 by a Perkins team member who will introduce the aims and purpose of testimony as community engagement.

The first thing we have been asked to do is for everyone 13 years or older to complete a survey about our church. This survey will provide important information about who we are as a congregation before we begin the grant work. The deadline for completing this survey is December 2. 


