Our Lenten study this year is the book Meeting Jesus at the Table, a study of the meals Jesus shared, the stories about banquets and dinner parties he told, and the miracles in which food was the miracle. "This is the joyful feast of the people of God! People will come from north and south and from east and west to sit at table in the kingdom of God." The author reminds us that these words are often used to invite us to the Lord's table. This table stretches around the world and across time. At this table, there is always room for whoever shows up, and there is always enough for all to be fed. Breaking and sharing bread has been at the heart of Christian worship since the beginning, and remains so today.

As part of this study, Grace members and friends who don't know each other, or don't know each other well, are invited to eat a meal together during Lent (February 24-April 1).
