We are now in the heart of the Lenten season. This Sunday we will look at the fifth lesson from *Meeting Jesus at the Table* titled "Empty Chairs at the Table." The lesson is based on Luke 14:15-24 when Jesus tells the parable of the great banquet. In the parable Jesus shares the story of a man who is preparing a great banquet and invites many guests. However, the invited guests make all sorts of excuses and turn his invitation down. The man, angered by all of the excuses made by the invitees to share in this exquisite meal, reacts by sending his servant into the streets and alleys to invite those cast out by the rest of society instead so that his house is full.

It makes me wonder; how often do we turn down opportunities to share in Christ's invitational love? Do we ever make excuses? Or what do we do about those who reject our invitations into this beloved community? What holds them back? Is it us? And even more complicated, what do we do about the chairs left empty at the table because of loss and separation? Join us this Sunday at 9 a.m. and 11:05 a.m. as we examine this multifaceted text and explore the ways it helps us understand our faith as Christians today.
