One of the hallmarks of a faithful Christian is generosity. It is one of the fruits of the Spirit in our lives (Galatians 5:22). Generous giving is encouraged in many places in Scripture. Proverbs tells us that our generosity to the poor is a loan to the Lord (Proverbs 19:17). Jesus promises a return on our generosity saying, "Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full – pressed down, shaking together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back" (Luke 6:38 NLT). Paul takes it even further with the Corinthian church: "Each of you must give as you have made up your mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance... You will be enriched in every way for your great generosity" (2 Corinthians 9:7-8, 11).

This Sunday we focus on #8 in God's Top Ten List: You shall not steal. The opposite of stealing is to "Live Generously!" Join us this Sunday at 9am and 11:05am as we worship God enthusiastically.

### **Peace and Global Witness Offering - October 1**

As we celebrate World Communion Sunday, we also collect the Peace and Global Witness offering, one of the four denominational offerings we collect each year. The Peace & Global Witness Offering encourages the church to cast off anxiety and fear, discord and division, and embrace our God's mission of reconciliation to those around the corner and around the world. A gift to the Peace & Global Witness Offering enables the church to promote the Peace of Christ by addressing systems of conflict and injustice across the world. Individual congregations are encouraged to utilize up to 25% of this Offering to connect with the global witness of Christ's peace. Mid councils retain an additional 25% for ministries of peace and reconciliation. The remaining 50% is used by the Presbyterian Mission Agency to advocate for peace and justice in cultures of violence, including our own, through collaborative projects of education and Christian witness.

Our Fall Festival is coming! Grace Presbyterian Church hosts this large community outreach event each year, but it takes a village to pull it off.
