## **Holy Land Trip Update - October 2024**

Information from the Educational Opportunities people on the ground in Israel is that beyond Gaza, the infrastructure remains in place, businesses are open, and physical life continues as usual. There is a huge desire by all living in Israel for tours to resume. Airlines are anxious to resume as well, as U.S. carriers took many flights to Tel Aviv. There is no date set by EO to resume tours to the Holy Land, but they are a lot closer than two weeks ago. Inside government sources expect major fighting to conclude soon and Gaza to remain occupied. Anticipated resumption of tours is early in 2024. Safety is their first priority, so be assured that they and other companies who have led trips to this region for decades will not resume unless it is safe to do so.

If you have registered already, EO has paused all payment requests for Holy Land tours until they resume. If we get to Spring 2024 and tourist travel to the Holy Land has not resumed, we can either reschedule the trip or change destinations. If you have not yet registered and are interested in going, wait until the Spring.

My advice is to be patient. We will meet again this spring to decide how to proceed. I still have the hope that we will be able to go safely.

### What Does it Mean to be a Deacon?

Being a deacon means a lot of things to a lot of different Christians. Deacons in the United Methodist Church are ordained clergy. In our denomination, deacons are ordained but one doesn't have to engage in years of theological study. Our understanding of the role of a deacon has evolved across denominational lines since the first seven deacons were called back in Acts 6. Even in our own congregation the role of a deacon has changed. Maybe you remember deacons as the people who spend lots of time visiting members in the hospital, or maybe you heard that they meet a lot and not really much else. It is true that deacons are responsible for a variety of different tasks. We meet, we make visits, we reach out to people, we care for people, we serve Communion, and we serve people, among many other responsibilities. In a nutshell, it's a ministry of compassion and service. Sometimes it seems like a lot, but if you ask a current member of our GPC Deacon Council, I believe they'd tell you it's a manageable responsibility and so unbelievably worth it. It's a vital ministry to our congregation and community, and it really does make a difference.

If you feel called to serve as the hands and feet of Jesus in this way, or even if you are on the fence, I encourage you to go to gracepc.org/deacons.
