- A food dish or 2 from your country - could be desert, candy, cookies, a well known dish, etc.

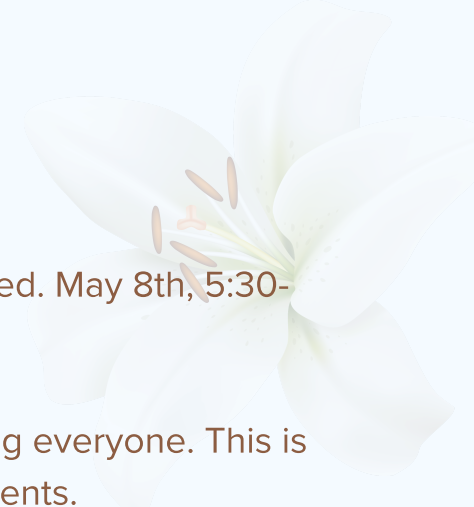
Who doesn’t love sampling food from around the world?

Blood Drive: Thank you Grace for the successful blood drive! We exceeded our goal with 15 donors giving at the Carter Blood Mobile last Sunday.

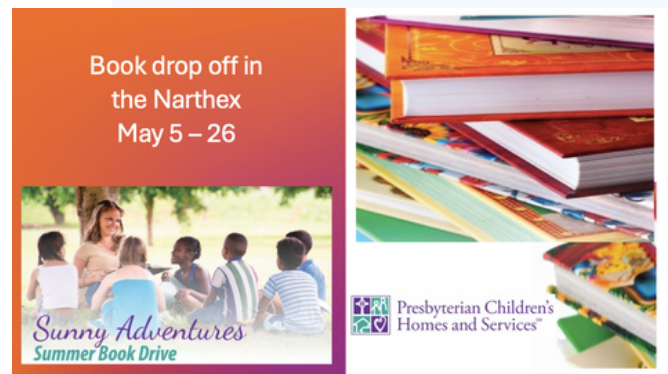
