Did you know that in the 18th century, there was a huge controversy in the church about music? Up to that point, most churches did not have hymnals. Those who did had only the words, no notes. A new idea came along. Why don't we put the words and the music in a book? People can learn how to read music, how to sing notes and even harmonies. To some it seemed like a great idea. To others it was scandalous. The controversy became heated. Rev. Thomas Symmes of Bradford, Massachusetts published the objections of those who did not want the new way. Here were some of the objections, as reported by James W. Moore in his book Attitude Is Your Paintbrush:

- 1. This is new.
- 2. These songs are not as melodious as the old ones.
- 3. The practice of reading music creates disturbances and causes people to behave indecently and disorderly.
- 4. The names given to the notes (do, re, mi, etc.) are bawdy and blasphemous.
- 5. It is needless; our fathers got to heaven without it.
- 6. It is a contrivance to get money.
- 7. Those who want this kind of music in the church are a company of upstarts; some of them are lewd, loose persons.

Of course, their fears did not materialize. Our choir is not too indecent or disorderly. Can we imagine not having our hymnal or all the great music that has come after these hymns with which to praise God? I can't! Music has so many superpowers in worship.

Join us this Sunday at 10am as we answer the question, "Why is music such an important part of worship?" and receive the blessings of Exultation singing and Credo ringing in praise to God.


