
Spice of Life Lunch - Aug. 14 at Noon


- Cost will be \$10 a team, and we will use the ESPN fantasy app (will be collected at signup)




Grief Group - Sept. 24

Stephen Ministry Training - Sept. 6

Stephen Ministry has been an integral part of the fabric of this congregation since 1985. When we became part of this new program, we were one of the first 100 in the world. There are now over 13,000 that have joined the effort to help others.

For those who wonder what Stephen Ministry is. One of the key phrases that best describe it what would be: "Christ caring for Christ's people through people." An individual is assigned to walk through a troubling time with you, in a confidential relationship weekly. This could be something temporary or more long term in nature.


It has been a while since we trained a group of new Stephen Ministers, and we want to open this up to anyone who might be interested in joining us. We will be training along side Corinth Presbyterian Church in Parker. Dena Dillard is a Stephen Leader with them.

Training will consist of Friday night, September 6th and Saturday, September 7th to begin. We will then meet for 10 consecutive Thursday nights at 7 PM. We would then conclude on Saturday, November 14th. We know this is a large commitment, but I would encourage anyone considering joining us to speak to anyone wearing a blue Stephen Ministry badge and see if they have found the training to be beneficial to them and their ministry to others.

You will get 2 workbooks and 3 books as part of the training materials. It costs you \$60 for the materials.


Interests: dance (modern/jazz), pop music, movies, volleyball, painting/drawing






