Grace Family,

Today we begin our summer sermon series: "Dear Church, love Jesus." It's a look at the letters to the seven churches in Asia Minor (modern day Turkey) in the book of Revelation. By the 90's of the first century A. D., there were many more than seven churches in this part of the world. It may be that John only knew of seven of them. But it also may be that 7 is a significant number in Revelation, meaning complete or all-inclusive. By identifying 7 churches, John and Jesus wish to suggest the messages are intended for all churches, wherever and whenever they may be. The messages are intended for Grace Presbyterian Church in Plano, Texas in 2025.

Why write letters? When these were written, there was no choice. A letter was the only form of personal communication they had. No internet. No texts. No posts or private messages on Facebook. Even with all our current choices, letter writing remains good practice. The writer of a letter becomes more present, intently concentrating on the one person to whom they are writing, and blessing them with carefully chosen words. The receiver knows that someone took the time and energy to think about just them and will know and remember the words by holding something tangible, something real, pulling it back out of the drawer whenever they want.

I've decided to write more letters. I believe God is calling me to write letters of encouragement to our church. You may have already gotten one this week. If you would like one, just check the box on your connection card and I will concentrate on you, pray for you, and hopefully bless you with a message from Jesus.

Join us this Sunday at 10:30am as we worship God enthusiastically and delve into the letter Jesus writes to the church in Ephesus (Revelation 2:1-7).


