November 2 is All Saints' Sunday, the day we remember those who have died. One gets the strongest sense in the gospels that Jesus does not accept death as the natural order of things. Jesus is against death. Every time Jesus came upon death, he was angered, moved, and saddened. Every time Jesus came upon death, he told the mourners to go away, the loved ones not to weep. Every time Jesus came upon death, he did something to interrupt it. Twice, Jesus reversed the death of someone's child by bringing them back to life.

In our text for this Sunday, Jesus runs into a funeral procession for a widow's only son (Luke 7:11-17). Filled with compassion, he stops the procession, touches the stretcher on which the dead man is laying, and commands him to get up, which he does. Of course, the crowd is filled with awe, praising God for this good news which spreads throughout the surrounding area.

I wonder what this tells us about life and death, and Jesus, and his care for those who mourn? Join us this Sunday at 10:30am as we worship God enthusiastically and remember that Every Single Person Matters to Jesus!
