Young David is left out in the field to tend the sheep when Samuel is looking for a king (1 Samuel 16:1-13). A "sinful woman" (we aren't told her name) is uninvited to a dinner for Jesus (Luke 7:36-50). Both stories show us that God sees so much more in other people than we do.

I wonder what this truth calls us to be and to do as church?



We plan to make: Five Can Chili

- 16 oz can of black beans
- 16 oz can of kidney beans
- 16 oz can of pinto beans
- 16 oz can of tomato sauce
- 10 oz can of diced tomatoes and green chilis (Rotel)
- 1 packet chili seasoning
- Optional: Cornbread mix with an individual applesauce cup

Breakfast Bags

- Granola bar, cereal bar or protein bar (please, no chocolate-covered items that will melt)
- Oatmeal cup, or individual cereal cup with a box of milk
- Juice box
- Fruit Cup
